Public Hearing on proposed Franchise Agreement with Maquoketa Valley Rural Electric Cooperative (MVREC) Mayor Behnken opened the Public Hearing at 5:05pm.

Motion by Bradley, seconded by Scherbring to adopt R-131-2022 Resolution Adopting Revenue Purpose Statement for the Use or Expenditure of Maquoketa Valley Rural Electric Cooperative Franchise Fee Revenues for the City of Manchester. Motion carried, all ayes.

Motion by Sherman, seconded by Schmitt to proceed with the first consideration and adoption of Ordinance 008-2022 An Ordinance Granting Non-Exclusive Electric Utility Franchise to Maquoketa Valley Rural Electric Cooperative by adding a New Section Establishing Terms and Conditions of the Grant of Franchise. Motion carried, all ayes.

### Public Hearing on the Petition to Vacate Plat filed by Jerome A. Krogmann & Rose A. Krogmann

Mayor Behnken opened the Public Hearing at 5:09pm.

City Manager Vick reviewed the request with the Council, noting the Krogmanns own all of the parcels within the plat they've requested be vacated.

There being no written comments on file and no oral comments to be heard, Mayor Behnken closed the Public Hearing at 5:10pm.

Motion by Poynor, seconded by Sherman to adopt R-132-2022 Resolution Vacating Plat of Wilson's Manchester Commercial Park Subdivision. Motion carried, all ayes.

### **Utility Rate Increases**

Motion by Scherbring, seconded by Bradley to proceed with the second consideration of Ordinance 007-2022 An Ordinance Amending the Code of Ordinances of the City of Manchester, Iowa, by Amending Provisions Pertaining to Utility Rates. Motion carried, all ayes.

### Police Hallway Remodel

Police Chief Hauschild reviewed the request to remodel the hallway with the Council, referencing the memo included in the City Council packet. Motion by Poynor, seconded by Bradley to approve the police hallway remodel project at an estimated cost of \$6,890.94 as requested by Police Chief Jim Hauschild. Motion carried, all ayes.
