

### FALL LEAF PICK-UP GUIDELINES & SCHEDULE

- Leaves may be put into the street 48-hours prior to your scheduled pick up day. Those in violation of the 48-hours may be fined.
- Leaves must be in the street before 7:00 a.m. on your scheduled day.
- Please rake your leaves into windrows on street 2-feet away from the curb line.
- Vehicles may not be parked within 50-feet of windrows.
- Leaves will not be picked up if they are in bags or containers.
- This pick up is for leaves only. Sticks, twigs, brush or garden debris must be taken to the compost site.
- Equipment may work ahead of schedule.



## 2020 Fall Leaf Pick-Up Schedule

**Section 1: MONDAYS: Sept.28, Oct. 5, 12, 19, 26, Nov. 2**  
 All areas south of Butler Street, but not including Butler Street

**Section 2: TUESDAYS: Sept.29, Oct. 6, 13, 20, 27, Nov. 3**  
 Butler Street to Union Street, including Butler and Union Street

**Section 3: WEDNESDAYS: Sept.30, Oct. 7, 14, 21, 28, Nov. 4**  
 North of East Union Street to East Acers Street; From North Franklin Street to the east, including East Acers Street and both sides of North Franklin Street

**Section 4: THURSDAYS: Oct. 1, 8, 15, 22, 29, Nov. 5**  
 North of West Union and West of North Franklin to Acers Street; then all areas North to the City Limits from Acers Street, not including East Acers or West Union

Please Remember - Crews do their best to stay as close to the published schedule as possible. Equipment does work ahead when possible, but work will take place in areas as shown on the map on the scheduled days. Likewise, equipment breakdowns or heavy rains can slow progress and snowstorms late in the season can curtail the program altogether. City crews will continue to pick up leaves sporadically AS TIME PERMITS after the published schedule has ended. However, this is not guaranteed. Residents on a strict time schedule are encouraged to utilize the City's Compost Site. The compost site is open from sun up to sun down.
